

### ON THE CUSP: STOP CAUTI (CATHETER-ASSOCIATED URINARY TRACT INFECTIONS)



#### CAUTI – Inpatient Initiative

- 8 cohorts, 955 hospitals, 1,595 inpatient units
- 15% relative reduction in CAUTI rate per 1,000 catheter days
- 6% relative reduction in ICU participants
- 24% relative reduction in non-ICU participants



#### CAUTI – Emergency Department Collaborative

- 3 cohorts, 274 hospital emergency departments



#### CAUTI – Long-Term Care Initiative

- 2 cohorts, 236 long-term care facilities
