Delivering educational content to reduce CAUTIs to more than **10,000 participants**

As of December 2013, the *On the CUSP: Stop CAUTI* (catheter-associated urinary tract infections) project registered more than 860 hospitals and 1,350 inpatient units (both ICU and non-ICU) and 121 emergency departments. The project has reduced **CAUTIs by 16 percent for participating hospital units.**

### 16 senior executives

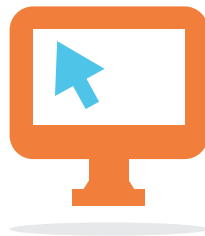
