Christopher J. King is a healthcare executive, educator, researcher and Fellow of the American College of Healthcare Executives. As the Associate Director of Health Services Administration and Director of Experiential Learning and Professional Development for Georgetown University, he conducts health services research with a focus on health equity and population health within the context of bridging the gap between the healthcare and public health sectors.

In his former role, Christopher served as the first Assistant Vice President of Community Health for MedStar Health, a \$4.6B not-for-profit healthcare system. Christopher demonstrated success in building a new department to apply more rigor and evidence in community-based planning, implementation and evaluation. His function provided programmatic and operational leadership for ten hospitals' community health activities. He was also responsible for developing, testing and evaluating innovative approaches aimed at improving the health of vulnerable and underserved populations.

Christopher has conducted presentations to national audiences and has served on an assortment of national committees. He has presented continuing education lectures on minority health and healthcare workforce development for the American College of Healthcare Executives. Most recently, his national investigations on screening and barriers to care among cancer survivors were published in the *American Journal of Preventive Medicine* and the *American Journal of Medical Quality*.
