

## Sunil K. Sinha, MD, MBA, FACHE

Dr Sinha currently provides expertise on health systems operations, quality and performance improvement and Medicare/ Medicaid regulations to organizations such as the Johns Hopkins School of Public Health, the Department of Veterans Affairs, the Iowa Foundation for Medical Care (IFMC), and Merck, Inc. He maintains his teaching and clinical affiliations at the Baltimore VA Medical Center.
